SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Dworak.

Now, I am not so sure that is really an arm's length negotiation, you know, when we walk out of the floor of the Legislature into the rotunda selling fund raising tickets that these people have total discretion and total option based on the need or the cause as to whether they desire or do not desire to buy the ticket. Now they may have that discretion but I just have some real serious reservations about that. I think this will stop or I am not suggesting there have been any abuses, I am not suggesting they buy a lot of tickets, I don't know, I have never had
