SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators should be in their seats. Please record your presence. Senator Higgins, will you please record your presence? Senator Koch, will you please record your presence? Senator Clark. Okay, the Clerk is authorized to take call in votes. Senator DeCamp, we have 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 excused absences.

CLERK: Senator Nichol voting aye. Senator Sieck changing from no to yes. Senator Remmers changing from no to yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 13 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the DeCamp amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The DeCamp amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Beutler, do you wish to advance the bill?

SENATOR BEUTLER: You betcha.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion before the House is....

SENATOR BEUTLER: If it's possible, I would move that the bill be advanced, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: There are two lights on. Senator Wesely, is your light on? And Senator Newell. The motion before the House is the advancement of the bill. Senator Wesely, do you wish to be recognized? Senator Newell, do you wish to be recognized? Okay. The motion is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor of whatever the number of the bill is being advanced vote aye, opposed vote no. 134. Does anybody else have anything they would like to say? Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 11 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Do you have any items you would care to read into the computer?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp asks unanimous consent to add his name as co-introducer to LB 134.
