districts, and if you are going to make the amount of people fit the district, you are going to have some, we will call it, gerrymandering, if you want to. There just isn't any way you can split the counties equally and come up with exactly the right number of people. So I think I support...I do support what Senator DeCamp has said. I think we need to think about this and talk about it. I know some of you voted against it because you were for the Warner amendment because it was a way out and we didn't want to face the music. So perhaps in a day or two we will have our minds made up just exactly how this can happen but I certainly wouldn't want to force the district upon a county, upon people, as Senator Goll has mentioned, that really haven't been aware that they are even in the process of being switched. So while we don't have time for a rublic hearing, I think we certainly have time to let this settle and let them have a chance to have a go at us if they don't like it. So I support the DeCamp idea.
