intagt, since a couple of good things have been added, since the net effect of the bill is very positive from my point of view I'm willing to support the amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Pirsch.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Thank you. I have a question of Senator DeCamp if he will yield.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Senator DeCamp, the only problem with the...with your shortened analysis is that it is to short for me to interpret. We added a specific amendment which stated that you must put the name and the mailing address of everyone who volunteered more than four hours, I think it was, to a campaign. Is that still in the bill?

SENATOR DeCAMP: No, that is part of the forty, lets say forty percent I eliminated. Reason, I think you would have five to six days, eight days maybe of arguing on this issue. There are some people in here that feel very intense about it, as you can see by what they kept doing to me over the last year. I took that out. I'm submitting that amendment that contains the Elroy Hefner and the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee, I am suggesting look, there are some reasonable basis for these things, look them over. Maybe next year you will come back and Peter and his friends will come back and say hey you know, some of these things DeCamp was offering really are more sensible. I'm not offering it at this time.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Thank you, Senator DeCamp. That was a provision that I was concerned about and I'm glad that you eliminated it. I can support the amendments now.

SENATOR CLARK: Is there any further discussion on the amendment? If not, Senator DeCamp, do you wish to close?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Like I say I'm not trying to waste your time, I'm trying to do it fairly quick and I think it is the half a loaf. I told Gordy McDonald, a good friend of mine, I told him on a couple of hills he should have taken the half a loaf and I think that he would still be alive today on a couple of his bills. I'm accepting the half a loaf ratner than wiping out the Commission, I'm saying lets make them function more efficiently and not be a
