one. If we cannot have discipline by voting the proper way on each issue as it comes up, then what we ought to do is vote out all the rules, period, and ad hoc our way through the entire session. Capable people like Senator DeCamp who can rally all kind of support will come to the forefront as usual. If we make the comparison of quality rising to the top, that's where I will be as usual, but we don't want to just suspend the rule because two issues that on the surface could look the same may really only be similar, but in essence they are different. So I think as Senator Beutler and Senator Dworak have pointed out, we can take each issue that comes up and deal with it at that time. But I am opposed to what Senator Marvel has offered.
