You have a public hearing on it and you do away with the law. That is how the rules apply to everyone else and just because someone has an adjective like Christian in front of them doesn't mean they should get special treatment. We've had a long, hard fight in this country to establish the principle that the law stands for everyone. People in my generation went to jail because they didn't want to go to the draft and they should have and the people in my generation didn't pay taxes because of that Vietnam War went to jail and they should have. It was an act of civil disobedience. They knew what they were doing and the law gave it to them until the law was changed. Now that is what should happen here today but because the cast is changed, because the list of characters is changed, this Legislature is prepared to do a flip that Jimmy Hartung would be proud of to accommodate special people...
