But those of you who have gotten everything out of this session you want, you should go home. You bet, because primarily it has been one of negativism, nothing very positive. But I submit to you there are some bills up here, that there are some people out there who are really interested in and for us to walk away and turn our backs and say the Governor has won is a concession I do not want to make. Thank you.
