On behalf of the Committee we ask for the confirmation of these nominees by the Governor for the various positions by this body.

PRESIDENT: All right, any discussion on the gubernatorial appointments as reported by the Education Committee by Chairman Koch? If not, then all those in favor of accepting the report confirming the appointments...gubernatorial appointments, vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Education Committee report.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries, the report is adopted. The appointments are confirmed. The third report, last report of gubernatorial appointments is by the Agriculture Committee. Senator Wagner will handle that. The Chair recognizes Senator Wagner.

SENATOR WAGNER: Mr. Speaker and members, on Thursday, May 7th, the Agriculture Committee...Agriculture and Environment Committee had a hearing and this hearing was on two members to the Environmental Control Council. We had two people there, Carl Swanson and Ted Regier. The committee held that hearing and voted favorably and I would like to give you a little bit of a rundown on these two people. I think they are very highly qualified. Carl Swanson is the Manager of the Technical Environmental Control Committee of Allied Chemical Company. He has been with Allied for around thirty years. He has a Bachelor Degree in Chemical Engineering from Iowa University and a Master of Science Degree in Mathematics from the University of Nebraska. Carl is a registered professional Engineer. He comes very highly qualified. And we have Ted Regier who many of you probably know. He has been active in agriculture. He graduated from the University of Nebraska in the College of Agriculture. He has a degree in Vocational Education. He has taught Vocational Agriculture for three and a half years. He has farmed since 1944. He is presently a Chairman of the Hamilton County Commissioners. Both of these men, I think, are very highly qualified. They come very highly recommended from Dan Drain. I move that the Chamber here vote upon their confirmation.
