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fiscal notes whenever amendments are adopted but the Fiscal office wasn't sure when they were supposed to be making those adjustments. We make it clear that they make them when we advance the bill to E & R Initial or E & R Engrossment and also if an individual member of the Legislature wishes to have that adjustment made in the fiscal note, he can request it. So it seems to me that these are clarifying changes to our rules, that they are necessary at this point and it is proper for you to consider and hopefully pass them today.

SENATOR CLARK: The question before the House is the adoption of the rule change on (a) and (e). All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote nay. It takes 30 votes.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting no.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Marvel, did you want to be heard?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, sir.

SENATOR CLARK: Go ahead.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I want to know what...I wasn't in the room when all this discussion took place. What are we voting on? It was not my impression....

SENATOR CLARK: We are voting on the division of the question, Section (a) and Section (e).

SENATOR CLARK: I wouldn't think so, but that is what they wanted to do, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Well, I object. I protest. Understanding that we would take an hour and discuss rules changes. We would not vote up or down. So I protest, Senator Wesely.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: 9 ayes, 14 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the proposed rules.

SENATOR CLARK: The motion fails. Senator Peterson, for what purpose do you rise?
