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is good enough to do that, then you readvance it to Final Reading and it still is going to take 33 votes to actually pass it with the E clause. So what happens is sometimes people are not on the floor and you try and get the bill back to add the E clause and it is kind of a slow day and you have the support but you don't have enough people and so you don't get it on and it causes a real problem. So this makes it a little easier to add the E clause.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of number two. All those in favor of number two vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the proposed rule number two, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is adopted. Now we are at number three.

CLERK: Number three has to do with being physically present in the Chamber to vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, what this rule change resulted from is Senator Wiitala had a situation last session that he was concerned about and brought the rule change to us. And what it says is if you are in the Chamber and you need to vote, you can get somebody's attention and they can vote for you and that sort of thing but no more phones against the buttons or tape down the buttons or anything like that. You have got to be in the Chamber in some physical form or another. So it seems to me that this is something we can all agree to. It just means that you have to be here in order to vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of item number three vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the proposed rule change number three, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried, the rule is adopted. Now item number four.

CLERK: Mr. President, item number four has to do with the motion to adjourn.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely.
