introducer and you say, hey, I've worked with you or I will work with you on the bill. I want to get my name on the bill and I'll work with you. He says, okay. Then you go to the body and you get unanimous consent and that is the way we did it last year, remember. After the bill was in you wanted to add your name, you asked unanimous consent to add your name. It was a perfunctory sort of thing. You add your name and it doesn't count against your total because the point is you limit how many bills were introduced but not after the bill is introduced, what difference does it make how many names are on it. That doesn't seem to be the difference so that would clarify that it wouldn't count against your total, this amendment would do that.

SENATOR CLARK: The question before the House is the adoption of the Wesley amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting no.

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted? Once more, have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President on adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR CLARK: The amendment lost. The next amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler would move to amend proposed rule change #14 by adding the following: "This rule shall not go into effect until February 1, 1982."

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, the effect of the rule would simply be to delay it and not put the rule into effect this year. I think we have to give some consideration to those who have planned their programs as Senator Warner indicated and to those who may have eight bills already filed. And so it would be acceptable to me and I hope to the body to delay...to put the rule into our rules but to delay the implementation of it until after the bill introduction period of this year. Thank you.

SENATOR CLARK: Is there any discussion on the Beutler amendment? If not, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote. Senator Beutler, do you want to be recognized?
