LB 263

SENATOR WARNER: We can take it up now. The amendment I sent up, Mr. President, was addressed or written I think to the bill but it could...rephrase it and be written to the committee amendment.

CLERK: Mr President, Senator Warner's amendment would strike Section 2, original Section 2 from the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the original Section 2 increases the per diem for this particular board and I know there is legislation in Senator...one of the committees, Government Committee... and the Appropriations Committee has bills dealing with per diems, expenses for all boards and it is going to be dealt with and I think it would be well to take this out of this issue so we can attain consistency which is the purpose of the other two bills across the board. So I would move adoption of the amendment to take that particular issue out of this bill since it will be and can be dealt with in other legislation that will be before us. I am not arguing the merits of a change...don't do it here.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Warner amendment to the committee amendments on LB 263. All those in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. The committee amendments as amended, Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: I move the adoption of the committee amendments as amended.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to adopt the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. These are committee amendments as amended to LB 263. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried. Amendment is adopted. Okay, the motion first is to advance LB 263. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried. Bill is advanced. Next.
