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only because of money and cowardice. There is so much that I find difficult to understand as a member of this Legislature and I have to go back again to the prayers every morning.

PRESIDENT: Half a minute, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You talk about being born again Christians, then when you have the opportunity to do the things that the one you worship told you to do, then you sit on your hands afraid to take that action. Remember all that is needed for evil to triumph is that good people do nothing, but even worse than that, that they do the wrong thing and it would be wrong not to support this resolution as Senators Fowler and Labeledz drafted it.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Higgins.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Thank you, Mr. President. Would Senator Schmit yield to a question, please?

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit, will you respond?

SENATOR SCHMIT: I yield.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Senator Schmit, did you vote for President Reagan?

SENATOR SCHMIT: I did.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Thank you, Senator. Would Senator DeCamp please yield to a question?

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp, do you respond to a question?

SENATOR HIGGINS: Senator DeCamp, did you vote for President Reagan?

SENATOR DeCAMP: It really doesn't matter whether I did or didn't. However....

SENATOR HIGGINS: Please give me a yes or no, Senator.

SENATOR DeCAMP: ...as a point of information...well, I don't have to.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Okay.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I didn't vote for him though. I am giving that as a generous gift to you, but that is an improper question.
