things that the state must pay.

SENATOR KAHLE: How much of an increase in salary would that be?

SENATOR WARNER: There is no increase in their basic salaries but there have been increases of course in Social Security, health insurance payments that they qualify for the same as everyone else.

SENATOR KAHLE: You are not in anyway then setting the salary for the next four years. You are just perpetuating what is now being paid out.

SENATOR WARNER: The salary would not be changed. Their basic salary would not be changed from what it currently is without.....

SENATOR KAHLE: Under this bill?

SENATOR WARNER: Pardon?

SENATOR KAHLE: Under this bill.

SENATOR WARNER: Under this bill. Any change would require the enactment of legislation if it was to be an increase, in their basic salary. Fringe benefits will change as those things change such as health insurance or as Social Security changes that would change but that is not income to them.

SENATOR KAHLE: Okay, this just takes care of that plus their present salary.

SENATOR WARNER: Yes.

SENATOR KAHLE: Thank you.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, my question I think follows along the same line and I notice that we have Judge's salaries here, but you say all of these additional charges have nothing to do with salaries, is that correct?

SENATOR WARNER: There will be no salary increase for any constitutional officer included in this bill. Any increase in the total appropriation is a result of Social Security adjustments or if it is a health insurance
