And Senator Johnson addressed that quite well, and I think we all have some doubts in our mind about that in the first place. Then you pile on top of that, is Driver's Education worth it in terms of the net safety effect? And now we have some doubts in our minds about that. And then you pile on top of that yet the fact that Vocational Education is going to be losing \$2 million, and Vocational Education is more important....

SENATOR CLARK: You have one minute left.

SENATOR BEUTLER:than Driver's Education. I think all of those three things together when you add them together force you to reach the conclusion that this \$1.3 million would be better spent on Vocational Education, and I would encourage you to vote for the amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CLARK: The question before the House is the adoption of the Beutler amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote. Record vote has been requested.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on page 1401 of the Legislative Journal.) 5 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

SENATOR CLARK: The motion lost. The next amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is offered by Senator Schmit.

SENATOR CLARK: Is Senator Schmit here today? Senator Schmit. Do you have another amendment after that? Here he is. Senator Schmit, on your amendment.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I apologize. Has the Clerk read the amendment?

SENATOR CLARK: No.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Would the Clerk read the amendment, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schmit would move to amend the committee amendments. (Read the Schmit amendment as found on page 1401 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature.
