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hands? I do. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed vote nay.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting yes.

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted on ceasing debate? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 5 mays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Debate is ceased. Senator Kremer, do you want to move for the adoption of the first part of the amend-ment? Do you have any closing remarks?

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, I have no closing. I do move for section one, the first part of the amendment, I move for the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR CLARK: The question before the House is the adoption of the first half, number one, of the Kremer amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting yes.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 7 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Kremer's first amendment.

SENATOR CLARK: Number one of the Kremer amendment is adopted. Now we go to number two. Senator Kremer on the second part of your amendment.

SENATOR KREMER: Again, Mr. Chairman, I have already explained it. It has to do with the assessment of the permits or the fees that shall be assessed to getting a permit.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, I would like once again now to raise the germaneness question on the second part of the amendment. The bill drafter indicated to me that that part of the amendment would go into the same section of statutes, 60-300 series, which is the statute that yesterday's amendment would nave gone into which is a different section, entirely different section of the statutes, and on the basis of yesterday's ruling, I would request that it be ruled not germane.

SENATOR CLARK: Did you talk to the bill drafter?
