Call. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no.

CLERK: Senator Nichol voting yes.

SENATOR NICHOL: Record.

CLERK: 9 ayes, 1 nay, to go under Call, Mr. President.

SENATOR NICHOL: The House is under Call. Will unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. All Senators please take your seat. Sergeant at Arms will you please round up those that are not around. Please record your presence when you come in. Senator Koch, there are four excused. We are looking for Senator Lamb, Senator Schmit, Senator Apking and Senator Higgins. Senator Koch, we are absent only Senator Schmit, do you want to proceed?

SENATOR KOCH: No, I think I would like to have Senator Schmit here because I'm always here when he has important bills and I think it is only fair that he be here.

SENATOR NICHOL: Okay, we are waiting for Senator Schmit. Did you want to go without Senator Schmit?

SENATOR KOCH: Lets start the roll call Mr. Chairman. I'm sure that Senator Schmit will be here by the time we get to the "S's".

SENATOR NICHOL: Proceed.

CLERK: Roll call vote.

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: I just want the Lincoln delegation to know that Mr. Roskins has approved this amendment so it is not offensive to the UN. . .

SENATOR NICHOL: No, no. . .

CLERK: 21 ayes, 17 nays, 7 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, and 1 absent and not voting. Vote appears on page 1568 of the Legislative Journal.
