They are true. So I think she has a very good amendment and we ought to give these people distinctive uniforms so that it is clear that they are wards of the state but that they are paying their debt to society, not only by serving time, lying in the penitentiary, or lying at the Women's Center at York soaking up all this largess that the state puts upon them, they will be out there working and earning a living. So I think Senator Higgins' amendment is good and it doesn't surprise me. It doesn't surprise me at all. It is a perfect amendment. It is offered at an opportune time and the perfect Senator offered it. So to show that I don't entertain any hostility or animosity because anger rests in the bosom of a fool, I agree with this amendment. I agree with it. I don't know how you make "F" but if you make "F", I am not an....I will support the amendment.

SENATOR NICHOL: Was there anyone else that wished to speak to the amendment to the amendment? If not, Senator Higgins, did you wish to close on your amendment?

SENATOR HIGGINS: Mr. President, I would simply say that I appreciate Senator Chambers' support of this amendment and I hope that everyone here will adopt the amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR NICHOL: That was the closing. The question is, shall the amendment to the amendment by Senator Higgins be adopted? All those in favor signify by voting aye, opposed nay. There is a request to read it. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Higgins would move to amend the Chambers amendment by inserting the following: (Reread Higgins amendment found on page 1568, Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR NICHOL: All those in favor of the amendment to the amendment signify by voting aye, those opposed nay. Have you all voted? Senator Higgins.

CLERK: Senator Nichol voting yes.

SENATOR NICHOL: Please vote. Please vote. Record the vote.

CLERK: 9 ayes, 11 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Higgins' amendment.

SENATOR NICHOL: The Higgins amendment to the amendment fails. We are back to the amendment. Senator Newell. While he is coming, Senator Goodrich.
