SENATOR WARNER: Number one, Senaotr Wesely offered the motion because he didn't happen to vote as a courtesy to me. So, you know, if you want to whip anybody around, whip me around. All I am suggesting, I concurred as I did on the original remarks that we did \$150,000 cut on the basis of the fiscal note supplied by the community colleges and I agree that their subsequent figures changed. All I am arguing at this point is that the \$150,000 would be reasonable I guess as long as you want to do it anyway, to come from the general fund in state operations. But the \$187,073 ought to come out of the money in 816. That is all I am arguing. So if it is reconsidered, we would offer a motion that changes the money here by an increase of \$150,000 and then I would prepare an appropriate amendment for 816A that would change the \$2 million that the tech schools get there to \$2,187,073. They come out the same but, you know, I am willing to go along with the calculation that we made in committee to make that correction. But I think the other correction ought to come out of the 816 money, not out of the state.
