SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Chairman and members of the body, I accept that. I think it is reasonable and I would hope the body would support the Koch motion as amended now under reconsideration. Thank you.

SENATOR NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Warner amendment to the Koch amendment which we are considering at this time. All those in favor of the amendment to the amendment please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted?

CLERK: Senator Nichol voting yes.

SENATOR NICHOL: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment to Senator Koch's amendment.

SENATOR NICHCL: All right, now we are back to the Koch amendment. Senator Koch, did you wish to say anything further about your amendment?

SENATOR KOCH: No, thank you. I think it's all....we understand it.

SENATOR NICHOL: The question before us now is the Koch amendment as amended. All those in favor signify by voting aye, opposed nay.

CLERK: Senator Nichol voting yes.

SENATOR NICHOL: Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Koch's amendment.

SENATOR NICHOL: The Koch amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment is offered by Senators Hefner, Marsh, Sieck and Fowler.

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Hefner, are you going to take this?

SENATOR HEFNER: Yes, Mr. President. Mr. President and colleagues, I handed out this amendment to you just a short time ago and what it does, on page 41, line 27, we strike "operated by mental retardation regional boards", and then, of course, the next page on page 42 we strike the same
