SENATOR NICHOL: Are there any objections? It is with-drawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is from Senator Haberman to increase Region 2.

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Haberman. Senator Marsh, were you going to handle this? Is this what I understand? Senator Haberman, do you wish to place your amendment behind Senator Marsh's? Is that what I understand?

SENATOR HABERMAN: I wish to have Senator Marsh's amendment replace my amendment.

SENATOR NICHOL: Then you wish to withdraw yours, Senator Haberman?

SENATOR HABERMAN: Yes.

SENATOR NICHOL: Is there any objection? The Haberman amendment is withdrawn. Senator Marsh. Oh, excuse me, Senator Marsh. Excuse me, Senator Marsh, I made a mistake. Your amendment is not next in line. We will be to it in a few minutes. Okay.

SENATOR MARSH: That is all right. But it is all right with me if Senator Haberman wishes to substitute this for his amendment and that was my understanding.

SENATOR NICHOL: I guess we have not been doing that and I don't want to start something. But I think we will get to it all right, Senator Marsh, in a little bit. Thank you, Senator Haberman.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is Senator Howard Peterson's.

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Howard Peterson.

SENATOR H. PETERSON: Mr. Chairman, this is a relatively clean cut amendment. What it does is postpone the salary increases to January 1, 1983, and to direct the Revisor of Statutes and the legislative fiscal office to prepare adjustments to the appropriations to reflect those reduced appropriations. It specifically would change the date from October 1, 1982, to January 1, 1983. I just believe that is all that is necessary as far as discussion is concerned. I think it is a decision this Legislature ought to make and we ought to have that opportunity to make that decision.
