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leave \$400,000 with the option. Now along with this amendment we need one further amendment and that would be the language that spells out transfers because we have over 300 people on the waiting list, and I think it is of utmost importance that we give the Department of Public Institutions the authority to put that money where it needs it the most. We are under a tight budgeting situation and I think it is extremely important. Now if it is needed more in the community programs and we do have over 300,000 out there, I want that authority there for DPI to give it to the community programs. But if they find they get extremely short in the Beatrice Developmental Center, I think DPI should have that authority on shift, and this would put \$100,000 over, then with the amendment to strike the movement it would give DPI free authority to put that money to where it would be in the best use of the state. So these are the two changes, I would like to see this amendment adopted and then the Marsh amendment as amended, and then one amendment striking the idea that the movement come ahead of those potential clients that have no services at all.

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Hoagland, did you wish to speak to the amendment to the amendment? All right. As far I know you are the last one and then we would have the closing on it. What we would like to do, ladies and gentlemen, is finish this amendment. Now we are on the amendment to the amendment. We would like to finish this amendment before we wind up the afternoon. So let's try to be succinct. Thank you.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Mr. President and colleagues, I just want to very briefly strongly oppose the Burrows' amendment to Senator Marsh's and the other members of the Appropriations Committee's amendment. Senator Burrows' amendment would increase Region 6's total appropriations by 1 percent and the rest of the money would stay in the state budget in order to transfer people into programs that are being cut back.

SENATOR NICHOL: Excuse me, Senator Hoagland, we are not on the Burrows' amendment. We are on the Dworak and Hefner amendment.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Sorry, I thought it was Senator Burrows' amendment.

SENATOR NICHOL: Oh, continue.
