against that but in reconsideration and talking to some people I think there is a valid need considering the new federalism, the cuts in student aid, and so I am resubmitting that amendment but in a different form and only asking for \$170,000 and asking you to please support it.

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Newell. Senator Chronister, did you wish to speak to this?

SENATOR CHRONISTER: Mr. Chairman, I move that this body adjourns until next Monday at 9:30.

SENATOR NICHOL: The motion is made to adjourn until next Monday at 9:30. All those in favor signify by voting aye, opposed nay. Machine vote. Have you all voted? We are voting to adjourn. Please vote. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 17 nays, to adjourn, Mr. President.

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Beutler, for what purpose do you arise? We are not adjourned yet. Okay. We are discussing the Wesely amendment and Senator Warner I guess is up. Senator Warner, did you wish to speak to this amendment? Okay.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I would rise to oppose the amendment. This is similar to what we discussed earlier again with the tuition assistance, and again while it is one of these meritorious it is a program that has not as yet been implemented, true. The court approved the law, but I would hope that we would not start a new program. Let me rephrase that. I would hope we would not start a program previously authorized but not yet implemented this year . I would hope you would vote it down.

SENATOR NICHOL: We have an amendment to the amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Newell would move to amend the Wesely amendment by striking the previous Morrill Hall amendment.

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, this is a tactic that Senator Wesely uses quite frequently and I just, you know, the reconsideration thing only this is another way to skin a cat. I offer this probably not as seriously as I could or should. I offer it just to make this little point that Senator Wesely is getting on my nerves and I wanted everybody
