building any less beautiful. This building has been very beautiful over the years without these new hearing rooms and I think it will still be beautiful, and I would expect that in a few years we probably will be able to build those hearing rooms. But all I am asking is that we defer it this year, take this \$495,000 out of this budget for this purpose so that we can have these funds available for other purposes.

SENATOR NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Vickers' amendment. All those in favor signify by voting aye, opposed nay.

CLERK: Senator Nichol voting yes.

SENATOR NICHOL: Please vote. There are 15 excused. Senator Vickers. Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: You say there are 15 excused?

SENATOR NiCHOL: That is right.

SENATOR VICKERS: Okay, I want a record vote. I want a record to show that those people that want to take away from state employees' salaries and so forth still want to have good facilities here.

SENATOR NICHOL: A record vote has been asked for. Please record.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on page 1601 of the Legislative Journal.) 20 ayes, 12 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR NICHOL: The amendment is not adopted. Senator Hefner, for what reason do you arise?

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, I move we adjourn until 9:30 Monday morning, April 5th.

SENATOR NICHOL: The question is, shall we adjourn? All those in favor signify by voting yes, opposed nay.

CLERK: Senator Nichol voting yes.

SENATOR NICHOL: Please vote. Have you all voted? Senator Hefner, for what reason do you arise?

SENATOR HEFNER: I would request a Call of the House, please. I would like to have those that are absent brought back to the Chamber so we can all see how they would vote.
