SENATOR LAMB PRESIDING

SENATOR LAMB: The morning prayer will be offered by Dr. Palmer.

DR. PALMER: Prayer offered.

SENATOR LAMB: Thank you, Dr. Palmer. Roll call. Senator Nichol, for what rease do you rise?

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. President, while we are registering in I wonder if I might have a point of personal privilege please?

SENATOR LAMB: State your point.

SENATOR NICHOL: Some weeks ago we granted Mrs. Audry Towater the right to paint a picture over here to our left and she has it here this morning, if you would like to look at it. It has been appraised at \$2,000, I understand. I think if we talk nice to her she might give it to us, if there is a suitable place for it according to the picture placing committee within the Capitol.
