

SENATOR HOAGLAND: (No response).

SENATOR LAMB: Senator Beutler, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature I would also like to raise the germaness question on this particular amendment. This amendment has to do with Section... okay, perhaps it would be in order to hear the amendment.

SENATOR LAMB: Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: I. . . we will withdraw the amendment, Mr. Speaker.

SENATOR LAMB: The amendment is withdrawn. Next amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have a motion on the desk from Senator Hoagland to suspend Rule 6, Section 5, Rule 7, Section 3 and vote without further debate and without further amendment on the advancement of LB 568.

SENATOR LAMB: Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Mr. President and colleagues, I put this rule suspension motion up this morning in anticipation of the possibility of our getting bogged down here at 9:20 p.m. here on April 5th. I might note that as of 15 minutes ago there were seven amendments in addition filed to this particular bill following this rule suspension motion. One by Senator Chambers providing legal counsel on DWI cases, I assume. One by Senator Stoney, by Senator Schmit, by Senator Chambers, by Senator Newell and then two more by Senator Chambers. Now, I think that basically the bill has taken the shape that a lot of us would like to see it. It is late, there are a number of other bills on Select File that we would like to get to, not tonight of course, but certainly tomorrow. I leave it to your own judgment as to whether to vote for this suspension motion. It takes 30 votes. What I am asking the body to do is permit the suspension of the rules at this point so we can move this bill over to Final Reading without any further debate without any further amendments.
