SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, a point of clarification.

SENATOR CLARK: All right.

SENATOR HEFNER: Are we talking just about the \$176,000, or are we talking about an additional \$300,000?

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Warner.

SENATOR HEFNER: I don't think Senator Warner made that quite clear.

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Hefner, the general fund amount is \$176,000. The reference to the approximately \$300,000 is to earmark language that earmarked \$300,000 of Title XX funds out of that block grant to go to the regions. The \$300,000 would be spent somewhere. It is the earmarking of it.

SENATOR HEFNER: In other words, that would go to all the regions then, the \$300,000? Is that corect?

SENATOR WARNER: It does, yes, it does now and it would go to all of them. It is not equal, you know, it is not an equal amount to each. I don't have it right here in front of me but...

SENATOR HEFNER: Who would determine what amount goes to different regions? Would that be your committee?

SENATOR WARNER: It is in the....I'm trying to find it here. It is in...it would be in the bill itself that would earmark it by regions. I can give you that figure if you want.

SENATOR HEFNER: Okay. This is okay. Thank you.

SENATOR CLARK: All those in favor of the motion will vote aye, opposed vote nay. It takes 30 votes. Have you all voted? Once more, have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on page 2014 of the Legislative Journal.) 31 ayes, 14 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The motion passes. The override carries. The next motion we have I think is on 413 to reconsider. Oh, go ahead.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Koch would move to override the Governor's line-item reduction which reduces the appropriations for Special Education, Department of Education,
