CLERK: Mr. President, Proclamation: "By virtue of the authority vested in the Governor by Section 8, Article IV of the Constitution of the State of Nebraska, I, Charles Thone as Governor of the State of Nebraska, believing that an extraordinary occasion has arisen, do hereby call the Legislature of Nebraska to convene an extraordinary session at the State Capitol on Friday, October 30, 1981, at 10:00 a.m. for the purpose of considering and enacting legislation relating to the following subjects: (1) Reduce appropriations approved by the 87th Legislature First Session and, (2) Lapse cash funds to the State General Fund. I direct the members of the Legislature of the State of Nebraska to be notified of the convening of the extraordinary session by mailing each of them a copy of this proclamation and witness whereas I have hereunto set my hand and cause the Great Seal of the State of Nebraska to be affixed this 27th day of October, 1981. (Signed) Charles Thone as Governor." Attached to that, Mr. President, is certification regarding the mailing of the proclamation. In addition, Mr. President, there is an amendment of call for extraordinary session. "I, Charles Thone, Governor of the State of Nebraska, hereby amend the call for an extraordinary session of the Legislature of Nebraska, October 27, to include in addition to the subject enumerated therein the following subjects. (3) Amend laws relating to aid families with dependent children as required by federal law and amend laws relating to child support enforcement as required by federal law. And witness where have I have here too set my hand and cause the Great Seal of the State of Nebraska to be affixed this 29th day of October, 1981. (Signed) Charles Thone, Governor."

Mr. President, attached thereto is also a copy of the requisite notice.

PRESIDENT: The Clerk will now read other letters and appointments on the desk.
