and an official appointment letter from Governor Thone appointing Senator Duda to serve in the 14th Legislative District. Those documents will also be filed in my office.

PRESIDENT: We might officially welcome Senators Duda and Apking. Senator Duda would you just stand so everybody can see you or maybe you won't be seen because there are so many people standing but then...there is Senator Apking. Welcome to Senator Duda and to Senator Apking. The Chair recognizes Senator Marvel, Speaker Marvel, on the motion of election of officers.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I'm sorry.

CLERK: On the motion, Senator.

PRESIDENT: Speaker Marvel, go ahead, on the election of officers. All right, Speaker Marvel, continue.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The agenda indicates that the following officers be elected to serve for the 87th Legislature, First Special Session: Clerk of the Legislature, Patrick J. O'Donnell; Assistant Clerk of the Legislature, Richard Brown; Sergeant at Arms, Ray R. Wilson; Chaplain Coordinator, Dr. Robert E. Palmer. I move the adoption of that motion.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to approve the election of the officers for the 87th Legislature, First Special Session. Any discussion? If not, all those in favor of the Speaker's motion to approve the designation of the election of the officers for the special session vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 46 ayes, 1 may, Mr. President, on adoption of the motion.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries and the officers are elected for the 87th Legislature, First Special Session. The next matter on the agenda, agenda item #5. We will just...hold on just a moment. Going ahead with agenda item #5, the Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that the rules of the 87th Legislature be used in this, the First Special Session of 1981.

PRESIDENT: All right, the motion is to adopt these rules. Amendment on the desk. Amendment on the desk, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp would move to amend
