CLERK: (Proceeds to read verification of vote.) 22 ayes...

PRESIDENT: All right since we have not completed the report, under these circumstances since you could not know we can have a roll call. I will rule that we can have a roll call vote at this time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Are there any absent, sir?

PRESIDENT: I don't believe so. Is somebody excused? None are excused so we have them all here. So we will proceed because of the difficulty with the voting record, we will proceed with the roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, go ahead. First, do you want the House under Call? I think we are all here.

SENATOR BEUTLER: If they are all present, Mr. Speaker.

PRESIDENT: I believe everybody is...we can't test the board to find out, so maybe you will want to technically go under Call. I don't know. Is there anyone that notices...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Let's just vote.

PRESIDENT: Do you want to proceed? Senator Hefner, I don't see over here. Oh, here he is, okay. Let's proceed with a roll call vote.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote as found on page 13 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 25 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the change.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. Are we ready then...any other amendments?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend Rule 5 by adding a new section 15, is that right, Senator? Or amending Rule 5, section 15, after the word "session" strike period and add: "except that any bill may be considered if 5 members sign a request for such consideration."
