through Senator DeCamp, the rules that we operate under in order to expedite activity this special session. I would like to urge you to use caution now in following some of the major changes we have made to those rules so that we do not end up fulfilling the prophecy of Governor Thone in being like arsonists with matches. I think we have to be very careful about the fact that, number one, we should expedite activity but, number two, we have to balance the fact that the public should be informed as to what we are doing and have a chance to express themselves. Number two, we have to be informed about the issues at hand and not move too quickly without really knowing the full set of issues and facts that we need to to make a judgment. I think we should move ahead quickly but at the same time, not try to move ahead so rapidly and try and just get the job done and out of here as quick as we can. That is not right. That is not the way we should be but I think we have done the right things in terms of expediting when we need to, the process but again I urge you to be cautious in suspending the rules and in trying to move too quickly as we move ahead in this special session. Again, I move the adoption of the rules as amended.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote as found on pages 14-15 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 9 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the rules.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The rules are adopted for the 87th Legislature, First Special Session. At this point, since it is now a quarter after twelve, the Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel for directions as to how we will proceed on the agenda. Where is Speaker Marvel? Right here.
