CLERK: Mr. President, the motion is that the membership of all Standing, Select, and Special Committees of the 87th Legislature, as amended by the Executive Board of the Legislative Council because of newly appointed members, be continued for the balance of the 87th Legislature.

PRESIDENT: Mr. Speaker, would you care to handle that motion then? Speaker Marvel.

SPEAKER MARVEL: It is my understanding that the basic purpose of this motion is simply to create a mechanism whereby the membership fits into the various committees. This is not an attempt to try to rid anybody of membership in a committee. So all this does is verify what we have already had and so I make a motion that this be... well I will read it to you, "that the membership of all Standing, Select and Special Committees of the 87th Legislature, as amended by the Executive Board of the Legislative Council because of newly appointed members, be continued for the balance of the 87th Legislature." You adopt this and you make your decision on any changes when we go into the next session.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? All right, seeing none, all those in favor of adopting the motion of the Speaker will vote aye, opposed nay. And again, we will have to go to a roll call vote. No, we can't go to any voice votes. Let's just have a roll...we will proceed with a roll call vote because it is the only way we can find out. Go ahead, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote as found on page 15 of the Legislative Journal.) 47 yes, 1 no, 1 not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The motion to approve has been adopted. All right now, Mr. Speaker, what do you wish to do now at this point? We are now ready for agenda item #7 or a recess for lunch, whichever you want. The Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion at the moment, to try to keep this as tight as possible, is to recess until two o'clock. And by that time the Governor should be ready to come in and make a speech and then we have the introduction of new bills.

PRESIDENT: The motion to recess is not debatable. Do you have a question of the Speaker, Senator Nichol? Of me? Alright, Senator Nichol.
