PRESIDENT LUEDTKE PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: Would you record your presence. We are going to experiment with the machine. Okay, the report is that Senator Haberman is here anyway. If the rest of you are not here why he is. PRESIDENT: All right, motion is for the President to appoint a committee to notify the Governor. Any discussion? If not, all those in favor of the President appointing such a committee signify by saying aye. Opposed nay. The motion carries. I will appoint the following members of the Legislature to notify the Governor: Senator Apking, Senator Rumery, Senator Goll, Senator Burrows and Senator Duda. Would the committee so notify the Governor. The Legislature will be at Ease until the committee has notified the Governor and returns.

SERGEANT AT ARMS WILSON: Mr. President, your committee now escorting His Excellency the Governor of the great State of Nebraska.
