SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

PRESIDENT: Okay, anything further? The Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel. All right, the Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel.

SPEAKER MARVEL: First of all, the Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee will not meet today but will meet tomorrow. Is that right, Senator DeCamp? Okay, the hearing is postponed. I would like to read one paragraph now and then I think there is another motion up there. Monday the Legislature will meet at 10:00 a.m. The Legislature will adjourn so members can attend an Appropriation Committee's information hearing on the Governor's bills. These hearings will be held Monday and Tuesday at 9:00 a.m. On Wednesday the Legislature will meet at 9:00 a.m. and the agenda will be General File debate on the Governor's bills. So for the next couple days you will convene according to the schedule at 10:00 a.m.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, is that debatable?

PRESIDENT: Senator Koch, this is not a debatable motion.

SENATOR KOCH: Then let's vote on it.

PRESIDENT: All right. The motion...does everybody understand....(interruption).

SENATOR KOCH: One question...one question...(interruption).

PRESIDENT: Does everybody understand what the motion is?

SENATOR KOCH: One question, Mr. Speaker.

PRESIDENT: Yes, sir.

SENATOR KOCH: On...and this is serious, the State Board of Equalization under law must meet by the 15th of November or a corresponding day? Is that correct?

PRESIDENT: Well, the 15th, or as I understand, as I have been advised, or the legislative session.
