SENATOR HABERMAN: All right, you heard Senator Warner say not to make a hasty decision so we are going to stand here, we are tired, we have got ten or twelve members missing, we have got three Attorney General's opinions and we are going to stay here until seven-thirty and then we are going to make a hasty opinion. I think this is serious enough that we should wait, cool down and have their meeting and come in Monday. We will be fresh and then we can get the issue settled. I think we are going to make a mistake if we try to do it in two hours and try to do it tonight. Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Your motion is not to recess but to adjourn then. Yours would be an adjournment motion.

SENATOR HABERMAN: All right, then adjourn until Monday which takes precedence over the recess.

PRESIDENT: That is correct. It does. So we did have a motion in between so it is proper to move to adjourn again so I will entertain your motion to adjourn because if you have one motion in between you can take it up again. So I will entertain the motion to adjourn until, when was it, 9:00 a.m., Monday morning? All right, Speaker Marvel, again you are the only one who can talk to that. Monday morning, not Saturday or Friday or any other day. He wants to put it off until Monday. All right, he has withdrawn it so we are
