SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there any discussion on Senator Hefner's business? Okay. Those in favor of item #5 which has been explained by Senator Hefner vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee's report, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the report is adopted. Senator Cullan.

CLERK: Mr. President, the Public Health and Welfare Committee reports on a confirmation hearing of Dr. Henry Smith. The report is found on page 75 of the Journal.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I urge you to adopt the committee's recommendation. Dr. Smith has been director of the Department of Health, I understand, for approximately eleven years and the Board of Health expressed confidence in him throughout that entire term and I think that he is certainly a qualified and competent individual and deserves the support of this Legislature. CLERK: Mr. President, the next one is offered by Senator Barrett as acting chairman of the committee of Business and Labor. The report is found page 77. It is in regards to Harvey D. Davis, Senator.

SENATOR BARRETT: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, a confirmation hearing was held by the Business and Labor Committee concerning the nomination of Harvey D. Davis of Omaha as a member of the Commission of Industrial Relations. Mr. Davis is a practicing attorney in Omaha, will be replacing Mr. Benjamin Wall whose term expired in June of 1981. The decision of the committee was unanimous and I urge the body to approve the nomination of Harvey D. Davis to the C.I.R.
