well at the hearing. We recommend him unanimously and ask that this Legislature approve his appointment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the Bert Garvin confirmation report.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The report is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schmit now offers a balance of his report.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I would like to offer for the consideration of the Legislature, the recommendation of the committee on Agriculture and Environment that Mr. Don Crosier, Miss Sylvia Wagner, Mr. Vernon Pearson all be approved for the appointment to the Department of Environmental Control or to membership on the Environmental Control Council. Mr. Don Crosier represents the petroleum industry. He has a long history of participation in this type of activity and will perform excellently. Miss Sylvia Wagner had many years experience with the League of Women Voters in areas of public interest. Mr. Vernon Pearson is a man who has worked with Natural Resources Districts and has a record of participation in that area which recommends him highly. We felt that they all merited a unanimous vote of approval from the committee. We recommend that to the Legislature for your approval.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of the report as presented by Senator Schmit vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting aye, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Marvel voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of that portion of the report, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The report is adopted. The Chair recognizes Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: The committee would also recommend for consideration by the Nebraska Legislature, the approval of the appointment of Ralph O'Conner to the Nebraska Gasohol Committee. Mr. O'Conner was first appointed by Governor
