Energy Office, Games and Parks Commission, Nebraska State Racing Commission, Department of Motor Vehicles, Board of Examiners for Professional Engineers and Architects and Military Department. Those, too, will be on file in my office, Mr. President.

Mr. President, Senator Hefner would like to announce that the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee will be meeting in their public hearing tomorrow in Room 1113 as opposed to Room 1517. That meeting is scheduled for 10:00 a.m. It is on an interim study resolution referred to Miscellaneous Subjects, LR 370, and again in the afternoon they will be meeting in Room 1113 instead of 1517. That is Miscellaneous Subjects, a change of hearing rooms, Mr. President. Finally, Mr. President, I received this morning an Attorney General's Opinion addressed to Senator Warner regarding constitutional revisions. That will be in effect for the balance of this Special Session. That opinion will be inserted in the Legislative Journal. That is all that I have, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Any other messages? All right, I guess we are...any other business to come before the body this morning? Senator Lamb, I guess we are ready for your motion.
