

LEGISLATIVE BILL 162

Approved by the Governor February 18, 1983

Introduced by Goodrich, 20

AN ACT to amend section 37-203, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to game and parks; to increase the issuing fee for certain permits as prescribed; to provide an operative date; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 37-203, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

37-203. Permits shall be issued by the commission and may be procured from the secretary thereof and from such other persons and corporations as may be designated by the commission to issue said permits and collect the prescribed fees therefor. Any person, firm or corporation, other than the secretary of the commission or an employee of the commission, who shall be authorized by the commission to sell said permits shall be entitled to collect and retain additional fees of fifty cents on each resident and nonresident hunting permit issued and twenty-five cents on all other permits issued as reimbursement for the clerical work of issuing the same, and collecting and remitting therefor.

Sec. 2. This act shall become operative on January 1, 1984.

Sec. 3. That original section 37-203, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
