## LEGISLATIVE BILL 199

Approved by the Governor April 18, 1983

Introduced by Constitutional Revision & Recreation Committee, Labedz, 5, Chairperson; Sieck, 24; Jacobson, 33; Rupp, 22; Abboud, 12; Fowler, 27

ACT to amend section 37-1109, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and sections 37-1111, 37-1105 and Revised Statutes Supplement, 1982, relating to park entry permits; to increase a fee; to provide when permits are required; to provide for duplicate annual permits; to change a penalty; to provide an operative date; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 37-1105, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1982, be amended to read as follows:

37-1105. The commission shall devise permits

in two forms: Annual and temporary.

(1) The annual permit may be purchased by any person and shall be valid through December 31 of the year for which issued. The fee for the annual permit shall be five ten dollars per permit.

(2) A temporary permit may be purchased by any

(2) A temporary permit may be purchased by any person and shall be valid until noon of the day following the date of issue. The fee for the temporary

permit shall be two dollars.

Sec. 2. That Section 37-1109, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

37-1109. The commission shall evaluate the areas of the Nebraska state park system and designate those areas, or portions of areas, for which a permit shall be required. The commission shall periodically reevaluate the Nebraska state park system and designate additional permit areas or reclassify permit areas as nonpermit areas as conditions and public use warrant. The commission may designate the dates for which a permit shall be required for any permit area.

Sec. 3. That section 37-1111, Revised

Statutes Supplement, 1982, be amended to read as follows:

vehicle to enter a permit area unless such motor vehicle to enter a permit area unless such motor vehicle has permanently affired thereto, in the manner prescribed by the commission, a valid permit, except as provided by section 37-1103. Such a permit shall be required for entry at any time of the year. Any person who operates a motor vehicle in violation of this section shall be guilty of a class w misdemeanor an infraction as defined in section 29-431. If the identity of the operator of a motor vehicle in violation of this section cannot be determined, the owner or person in whose name such vehicle is registered shall be held prima facie responsible for such violation and shall be guilty of a class w misdemeanor an infraction.

Sec. 4. (1) In addition to the permits authorized in section 37-1105, the Game and Parks Commission shall design a duplicate annual permit which may be purchased for one half the fee of an annual permit.

(2) The registered owner of two or more vehicles may purchase a duplicate annual permit for one of such vehicles per year. The duplicate annual permit may be purchased from Game and Parks Commission offices and designated commission-staffed areas, either by mail or in person. A duplicate annual permit may be obtained at any time during the year upon proof of purchase of an annual permit, in compliance with Game and Parks Commission rules and regulations.

(3) Fees from duplicate annual permits shall be subject to the provisions of section 37-1114.

Sec. 5. This act shall become operative on

January 1, 1984.

Sec. 6. That original section 37-1109, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and sections 37-1105 and 37-1111, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1982, are repealed.
