

LEGISLATIVE BILL 498

Approved by the Governor March 15, 1985

Introduced by Chambers, 11

AN ACT relating to publications; to amend section 49-617, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and section 24-209, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1984; to change distribution as prescribed; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 24-209, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1984, be amended to read as follows:

24-209. (1) One copy of the Supreme Court Reports shall be furnished by the Supreme Court to each judge of the Supreme, district, separate juvenile, workmen's compensation, and county courts, to each county law library, to each state library, to each officer of the executive departments of this state, to the Clerk of the Legislature, and to each judge of the United States District and Circuit Courts of this state; to the Legislative Council, two copies; to the library of the College of Law of the University of Nebraska, as provided in sections 85-176 and 85-177; to the Nebraska Publications Clearinghouse, eight copies; and to the State Court Administrator's Office, up to ten copies.

(2) One advance copy of the opinions of the Nebraska Supreme Court in pamphlet form, known as the Nebraska Advance Sheets, shall be furnished to each judge of the Supreme, district, separate juvenile, county, workmen's compensation, and municipal courts, as many advance copies as may be requested by the members of the Legislature one advance copy shall be furnished to the Clerk of the Legislature, two advance copies shall be furnished to each standing committee of the Legislature, up to twenty-five five advance copies shall be furnished to the Attorney General, and up to twenty advance copies shall be furnished to the State Court Administrator shall be furnished as many advance copies as he or she deems necessary for the operation of the Supreme Court.

(3) The balance of the Supreme Court Reports and Nebraska Advance Sheets shall be sold as called for at such price as shall be prescribed by the Supreme Court. The Supreme Court shall also prescribe the price for microform copies of the reports. The money received from such sales shall be paid into the Supreme Court Reports Cash Fund which is hereby created. ~~On April 12, 1984, any money in the Supreme Court Reports Reveiving Fund shall be transferred to the Supreme Court Reports Cash Fund.~~

(4) Upon request from any office or entity entitled to free copies of the Supreme Court Reports or the Nebraska Advance Sheets, the court may stop sending the publications to such office or entity until the request is withdrawn.

Sec. 2. That section 49-617, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

49-617. The Revisor of Statutes shall cause the statutes to be printed. The printer shall deliver all completed copies to the State Librarian. These copies shall be held and disposed of by such librarian as follows: Sixty copies to the Nebraska State Library to exchange for statutes of other states; five copies to the Nebraska State Library to keep for daily use; not to exceed twenty-five copies to the Nebraska Legislative Council for bill drafting and related services to the Legislature and executive state officers; as many copies to the Attorney General as he or she has attorneys on his or her staff; eight copies to the State Court Administrator; not to exceed twenty copies to the Attorney General; twelve copies to the Tax Commissioner; eight copies to the Nebraska Publications Clearinghouse; six copies to the Public Service Commission; four copies to the Secretary of State; four copies to the Clerk of the Nebraska Legislature for use in his or her office and two three copies to be maintained in the legislative chamber, one copy on each side of the chamber and one copy at the desk of the Clerk of the Legislature, under control of the sergeant at arms; two copies each to the Governor of the state, the Chief Justice and each Judge of the Supreme Court, the Clerk of the Supreme Court, the Reporter of the Supreme Court, ~~the Court Administrator~~, the Auditor of Public Accounts, the Commissioner of Labor, and the Revisor of Statutes; one copy each to the Secretary of State of the United States, the library of the Supreme Court of the United States, the Adjutant General, the Air National Guard, the Commissioner of Education, the State Treasurer, the Board of Educational Lands and Funds, the Director of Agriculture, the Director of Administrative Services, the Director of Aeronautics, the Director Department of Economic Development, the Director of the Public Employees Retirement Board, the Director of Health, the Director-State Engineer, the Director of Banking and Finance, the Director of Insurance, the Director of Motor Vehicles, the Director of Veterans' Affairs, the Director of Water Resources, the Director of Social Services, the Director of Public Institutions, the Director of Correctional Services, the Nebraska Emergency Operating Center, each judge of the Nebraska Workmen's Compensation Court, each judge of the Commission of Industrial Relations, the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission, the Nebraska Natural Resources Commission, the State Real Estate Commission, the secretary of the Game and Parks

Commission, the Board of Pardons, each state institution under the Department of Public Institutions, each state institution under the State Department of Education, the State Surveyor, the Nebraska State Patrol, Purchasing Agent, State Personnel Office, Nebraska Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board, Board of Trustees of the Nebraska State Colleges, each of the Nebraska state colleges, each district judge of the State of Nebraska, each judge of the county court, each judge of a separate juvenile court, the Lieutenant Governor, each United States Senator from Nebraska, each United States Representative from Nebraska, each clerk of the district court for the use of the district court, the clerk of the Nebraska Workmen's Compensation Court, each associate county judge, each county attorney, each county public defender, and each county law library of the State of Nebraska, and the inmate library at all state penal and correctional institutions, and each member of the Legislature shall be entitled to two complete sets, and two complete sets of such volumes as are necessary to update previously issued volumes, but each member of the Legislature and each judge of any court referred to in this section shall be entitled, on request, to an additional a ~~third~~ complete set. Copies of the statutes distributed without charge, as above listed, shall be the property of the state or governmental subdivision of the state and not the personal property of the particular person receiving a copy. Distribution of statutes to the library of the College of Law of the University of Nebraska shall be as provided in sections 85-176 and 85-177.

Sec. 3. That original section 49-617, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and section 24-209, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1984, are repealed.
