SENATOR LYNCH: Mr. President and senators, I move that the rules, as now in our possession, be adopted for today only, Wednesday, January 4, 1989. I move the adoption of the resolution.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted. We are going to have an appointment of temporary officers. Senator Bernice Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Mr. President, I move that we appoint Mr. Patrick J. O'Donnell as temporary Clerk of the Legislature, and Mr. Carl Kamprath as temporary Sergeant at Arms.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator Labeledz. Any discussion? If not, the question is the adoption of these two temporary officers. All those in favor state aye. Opposed nay. They are appointed. Senator Lowell Johnson, please.

SENATOR L. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I move that we proceed to the election of five persons to serve as the Committee on Credentials who will forthwith report to the Legislature on the credentials of those claiming to be elected to the Legislature in the general election in November, 1988.

PRESIDENT: First we will approve the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. So be it. Now the Chair will entertain nominations from the floor. Senator Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Yes, Mr. President, thank you. I nominate Senator Ernie Chambers as a committee member of the Credentials Committee.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Chambers has been nominated. Senator Moore, please.
