Now we are ready to vote on it. All those in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed nay. It is passed. Now we have the Committee on Credentials elected. The Committee on Credentials, Senator Warner, you will go to 2102 and we will stand at ease or sit at ease until you return. Do you have any idea of how long you are going to be, because that is going to be the first question I will be asked? All right, we will be at ease until we hear from the Committee on Credentials, which might be a few minutes, it might be a long time. Senator Chambers says two or three minutes.
