PRESIDENT: Senator Lamb, please, for the Fourth District.

SENATOR LAMB: The members selected in the caucus group for Committee on Committees from District 4, Senator Rogers, Senator Scofield, and Senator Lamb.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the report of the chairmen of the four districts. I would entertain a motion to elect these folks to the Committee on Committees as stated by their chairmen. Do I have such a motion? Senator Goodrich.
