SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, I move that nominations be closed, that Senator Labedz be proclaimed chairperson by a unanimous affirmation.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. Senator Richard Peterson is the Executive Vice-Chairman. Thank you. (Applause.) We move on to the caucuses for the Executive Board, District 1, Senator Warner.
