SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I move that we unanimously declare Senator Johnson Chairman of the Agriculture Committee.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. Senator Rod Johnson is Chairman of Agriculture. (Applause.) We will move on to Chairman of Appropriations, Senator Warner, please.
