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if you will, Senator Scofield, Senator Weihing, and Senator Lowell Johnson. So if you three would come up and tabulate the ballots, Senator Scofield, Senator Lowell Johnson, and Senator Weihing, we will have an honest committee up here to record the ballots. Are you reluctant as an honest committee person, Senator Scofield? I understand that Senator Landis received 31 votes and Senator Conway 18 votes, so Senator Landis would be the new Chairman of Business and Labor. Congratulations. (Applause.) I had better change that to Banking Committee instead of Business and Labor, excuse me, the Banking. Now we will move on to Business and Labor. Senator Abboud, please.

SENATOR ABOUD: Well, Mr. President, colleagues, I noticed that when Senator Lowell Johnson and Senator Jerry Warner and Senator Richard Peterson placed their names in nomination, that no one ran against them. So following that precedent, hopefully, I decided to place myself in nomination for Chairperson of Business and Labor Committee. I have been in the Legislature for the past six years and I have done, I feel, a fair and competent job. I pledge that is what I would be as chairperson of that committee.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Schellpeper, please.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Mr. President and members, it is with a great deal of pride that I nominate George Coordsen for the Chairman of the Business and Labor. I have known George the last two years and I have found out that he is a very fair, dedicated senator. I think that he would make a very good chairman. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Pirsch, please.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. I appreciate the opportunity to submit my name into nomination for the Chairman of Business and Labor. I have been in the Legislature ten years, and those of you who have worked with me, I believe, think me to be fair and conscientious. A Business and Labor Committee Chairperson, as any committee chairperson, should be able to administer and schedule bills fairly and also to be able to articulate the committee's actions on the floor. I would like the opportunity to serve in the Legislature as Chairperson of the Business and Labor Committee, and I hope that you could vote for me. Thank you.
