Mr. President, I have received from the State Auditor, I'm sorry, Mr. President. The first item I have are a series of reports, filed pursuant to LB 1012, from a variety of state agencies with regards to their personnel policies on the subject of AIDS, as required under Section 1012. I have a series of reports from the Department of Roads regarding statement of deposits in the Highway Cash Fund; the minutes of the Board of Public Roads and Classifications and Standards meeting from the meeting of October 21, and November 18.
