PRESIDENT NICHOL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: Ladies and gentlemen, welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. We have with us today, as our chaplain of the day, Reverend Dan Davis who is the Association Regional Minister with the Christian Churches of Nebraska. Would you please rise for Chaplain Davis.
