SENATOR PETERSON: Mr. President, LB 22 makes numerous internal changes. I ask you to advance this bill to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 22.

PRESIDENT: LB 22 advances to E & R Initial. LB 23.

CLERK: LB 23, Mr. President, by Senator Labeledz as Chair of the Board. (Read title.) Introduced on January 5, referred directly to General File, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Richard Peterson, please.

SENATOR PETERSON: Mr. President, LB 23, this bill makes internal changes by eliminating duplicative and inconsistent language and by harmonizing certain provisions. I move that this bill be advanced to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the explanation. The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the advancement of LB 23, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 23 advances. LB 24.

CLERK: LB 24 offered by Senator Labeledz as Chair of the Board. (Read title.) It was introduced on January 5, referred directly to General File, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Peterson, please.

SENATOR PETERSON: Mr. President, LB 24, this is a very simple bill which harmonizes provisions relating to the election of a Register of Deeds. I move that LB 24 be advanced to E & R Initial.
